Discussion started with Daniel Pautzke on property on Indian Point Rd with other owners on this same road, making comments on how long property up for sale, discussion on fair auction, open auction and auction open to public-no forced sale, and the hope that the valuation would be lowered closer to the purchase price. Discussion by Board Members to apply same logic for 5 Parcels listed above and lower sales price and add 5%. SLC noted that price will need to be rounded up to the nearest 100<sup>th</sup>.

**Other Property Discussion:**

Discussion on the many covenants when property was purchased, there are no comparable sales. Indian Point is not well maintained. SLC explained that access changed on valuation and that valuation goes by sales only. No adjustments to be made.

Carl & Bonnie Spars- 270-0087-00140

Discussion-Discussion that there is a good portion of ledgerrock. Discussion by owners on change of footage from 190' to 215'. Also discussion that is given 40% reduction for shape adjustment and ledge rock. SLC explained that 130' of shoreline still receives the 40% reduction, but 85' does not. Board recommends no changes and mentioned next steps would be to appeal to the County, refer to tax valuation notice and the burden of proof will be on the homeowners that the assessed value is incorrect.

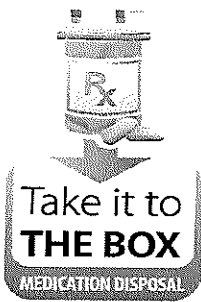

RE: Police contract coverage

During our Dec 17<sup>th</sup> negotiations with the Police department employees and their union representative, it was agreed to check with the City of Tower to determine if there is interest in eliminating the "on-call" time for the months of February, March and April. The present contract between Breitung and Tower requires on- call coverage throughout the year, this would eliminate coverage during the off shifts of the chief, supervising officer and part time coverage for these three months.

The benefit would be savings of approximately \$2,000 for the department which we are proposing to split 50% to each community, thus saving the City of Tower \$1,000 from the base contract for this change.

The risk would be that an incident occurs and the affected parties would have to wait for the response from St. Louis County. These three months were selected because the likelihood of an event occurring is minimal due to seasonal factors vs. the summer and fall months of the year when more activity occurs.

If you agree to proceed with this change, we will contact St. Louis County of the coverage changes during these months. The monthly payment then from the City of Tower to Breitung would be reduced by \$333.33 for the months of February, March and April.

Our next meeting is January 21<sup>st</sup> and would appreciate a reply in order for us to properly implement this schedule change.

WHEREAS, the policy of the State of Minnesota as declared in Minnesota Statutes 353.63 is to give special consideration to employees who perform hazardous work and devote their time and skills to protecting the property and personal safety of others; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes Section 353.64 permits governmental subdivisions to request coverage in the Public Employees Police and Fire plan for eligible employees of police departments whose position duties meet the requirements stated therein and listed below.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board, of Township of Breitung hereby declares that the position titled Police Officer, currently held by Cody Vail, meets all of the following Police and Fire membership requirements.

1. Said position requires a license by the Minnesota peace officer standards and training under sections 626.84 to 626.863 and this employee is so licensed.
2. Said position's primary (over 50%) duty is to enforce the general criminal laws of the State;
3. Said position charges this employee with the prevention and detection of crime;
4. Said position gives this employee gives this employee the full power of arrest, and
5. Said position is assigned to a designated police or sheriff's department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this governing body hereby requests that the above-named employee be accepted as a member of the Public Employees Police and Fire Plan effective the date of May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
