The Town of Breitung Does Ordain:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING

Section 1. <u>Prohibitions; Stopping, Parking.</u> No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following places:

- (1) On a sidewalk;
- (2) In front of a public or private driveway;
- (3) Within an intersection;
- (4) Within ten feet of a fire hydrant;
- (5) On a crosswalk;
- (6) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection;
- (7) Within 30 feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a roadway;
- (8) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by signs or markings;
- (9) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
- (10) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station within 75 feet of said entrance when properly sign-posted;
- (11) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic:
- (12) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- (13) Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a highway or within a highway tunnel, except as otherwise provided by ordinance;
- (14) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping.

No person shall move a vehicle not owned by such person into any prohibited area or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful.

No person shall, for camping purposes, leave or park a house trailer on or within the limits of any highway or on any highway right of way, except where signs are erected designating the place as a camp site.

No person shall stop or park a vehicle on a street or highway when directed or ordered to proceed by any peace officer invested by law with authority to direct, control, or regulate traffic.

Section 2. Parking. Subdivision 1. Parallel to curb. Except where angle parking is permitted by local ordinance, each vehicle stopped or parked upon a two-way roadway where there is an adjacent curb shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of the vehicle parallel with and within 12 inches of the right-hand curb, provided, that such exception shall only apply to a state trunk highway after approval by the commissioner.

Subd. 2. Where no curb. Upon streets and highways not having a curb each vehicle stopped or parked shall be stopped or parked parallel with and to the right of the paved or improved or main traveled part of the

street or highway.

Section 3. <u>Violations</u>. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$3.00 if the fine is paid within 48 hours. If payment is delayed beyond that time, a penalty of \$3.00 shall be added. Any person violating Section 2 of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$1.00 if the fine is paid within 48 hours. If payment is delayed beyond that time, a penalty of \$2.00 shall be added.

All fines and penalties must be paid within seven (7) days of issuance of the traffic tag. Persons wishing to plead not guilty shall appear before the County Court or Traffic Violation Bureau within seven (7) days of issuance of the tag and arrange a date for arraignment. Any person failing to make payment within seven (7) days or failing to appear before the Court or Traffic Violation Bureau within seven (7) days shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00.

The Ordinance Regulating Parking was adopted by the Town Board of Breitung on the Alba day of May, 1976.
