CARES ACT

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) St. Louis County Funding Overview

Rev. 1.0 (5-2020)

Background: The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed into law by the President on March 27, 2020. CARES includes \$2 trillion in economic relief intended to protect the American people from the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19.

On April 2, 2020, St. Louis County received notification of funding allocations from the CARES Act for use to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The allocations are flowing through two existing programs administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The St. Louis County area of CARES funding eligibility is all of St. Louis County outside the Duluth city limits. Duluth also received notice of CARES Act allocations to be used within the city limits.

The following information provides residents, businesses, and agencies guidance on the potential use of the COVID-19 funding by St. Louis County.

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV)

Purpose:
